



2020 Driggs Snowscapes Rules & Information

Teams of 3-5 members may compete

- ❄️ Participants aged 15-17 are welcome with parental approval and at least 3 teammates who are over 18
- ❄️ Participating minors also accepted through school affiliation with adult supervision on-site
- ❄️ Experienced soloists will be considered
- ❄️ All team members will be required to sign a liability waiver

Snowscapes will provide a blank snow block of either 6'x6'x8' or 8'x8'x8' and water to use for sculpting.

Teams will have 4 full days to carve their sculptures using hand tools

- ❄️ No colorants or power tools allowed
- ❄️ Ice accents may be used - must not be more than 5% of sculpture
- ❄️ Further guidelines & tips on tools will be sent to competing teams
- ❄️ Experienced out-of-town teams may qualify for benefits on lodging and meals - please contact for details.

Sketch Submissions:

- ❄️ Have fun and use your imagination!
 - This is a family friendly event, please refrain from political subjects or explicit nudity
 - Logos or advertising themes are not allowed
- ❄️ Provide up to three simple line drawings of your proposed sculpture that are at least 5"x5"
- ❄️ Photos of 3D mockups accepted in addition to sketch
- ❄️ Please submit materials in JPG or PDF form if submitting via e-mail

December 1, 2019 Deadline for entries submitted in person to Driggs City Hall or online at driggssnowscapes.org

December 5, 2019: Applications are judged, artists notified via e-mail

January 14-17, 2020: Official sculpting days from 8am -10pm

January 18, 2020: Finished sculptures on display for public voting and judging. Event concludes Awards Ceremony followed by the 9th Annual Snow Ball!
