



# 2022 Driggs Snowscapes Rules & Information

Teams of 3-5 members may compete

- ❄️ Participants aged 15-17 are welcome with parental approval and at least 2 teammates who are over 18
- ❄️ Participating minors also accepted through school affiliation with adult supervision on-site
- ❄️ Experienced soloists will be considered
- ❄️ All team members will be required to sign a liability waiver

Snowscapes will provide a blank snow block of either 6'x6'x8' or 8'x8'x8' and water to use for sculpting.

Teams will have 4 full days to carve their sculptures using hand tools

- ❄️ No colorants or power tools allowed
- ❄️ Ice accents may be used - must not be more than 5% of sculpture
- ❄️ Further guidelines & tips on tools will be sent to competing teams
- ❄️ Experienced out-of-town teams may qualify lodging and meals

**November 28, 2022:** Postmark Deadline for entries submitted via mail to Driggs Snowscapes PO Box 1286, Driggs, ID 83422

**December 1, 2021** Deadline for entries submitted online at [driggssnowscapes.org](http://driggssnowscapes.org) or in person to Driggs City Hall

**December 5, 2021:** Applications are juried, artists notified via e-mail

**January 17-21, 2022:** Official sculpting days from 8am -10pm

**January 22, 2022:** Finished sculptures on display for public voting and judging. Awards Ceremony during the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Snow Ball!
