Dear Snow Sculptor,

Congratulations! You and your team have been selected to participate in **SnowScapes--*The Art of Sculpting Snow*** in Driggs, Idaho, part of the Teton Valley Great SnowFest! The City of Driggs, Idaho and the Downtown Driggs Community Association are very excited. **Please read all three components of this acceptance package, which include: this Acceptance Letter, the “Tools for Sculptors” sheet, and the “Finished Sculpture Judging Criteria” sheet. All this information will be posted by this weekend to [www.driggssnowscapes.org](http://www.driggssnowscapes.org). Please share this information with all your teammates!**

Although we will have a few sculpting tools on site to loan, **teams are responsible** for bringing all their own tools. Please start gathering and making your tools now. You will need one or more ladders, small scaffolding set up, and a large tarp to shield the sun. Attached is some compiled information on useful tools and suggestions on translating your design into the larger form. If you are new to it, we encourage you to do your own web research to learn as much as you can about the process of sculpting snow!

Water will be provided on site, as well as warm drinks, soups, and homemade bread, courtesy of Seniors West of the Tetons. There will be bathrooms and warm areas on site. Tools can be stored indoors each night in a large van provided on site. We are expecting to have illumination each night till 10 PM. Alcohol, drugs, and cigarette smoking are prohibited on site.

Artist teams are cordially invited to attend the **Artists' Reception** on Monday, January 13 5-7pm at the Huntsman Springs' Barn. Refreshments and drinks will be served to welcome teams and give time to get to know one another before sculpting begins the following morning.

**Our first and only meeting will be Tuesday, January 14 at 9 AM inside the Driggs City Center.** All sculptors should be present at 9 AM to register, get block assignments, and sign waivers. Sculpting may begin after this meeting. Teams will be allowed to sculpt from dawn until 10 PM each evening from Tuesday, January 14-Friday, January 17.

On Saturday, January 18, the finished sculptures will be showcased and juried for People's Choice and cash prizes by our qualified jurors. These awards and locally created trophies made of ceramic, mixed-media, and glass will be presented around 6 PM on site, just before the **SnowBall** gala extravaganza.
